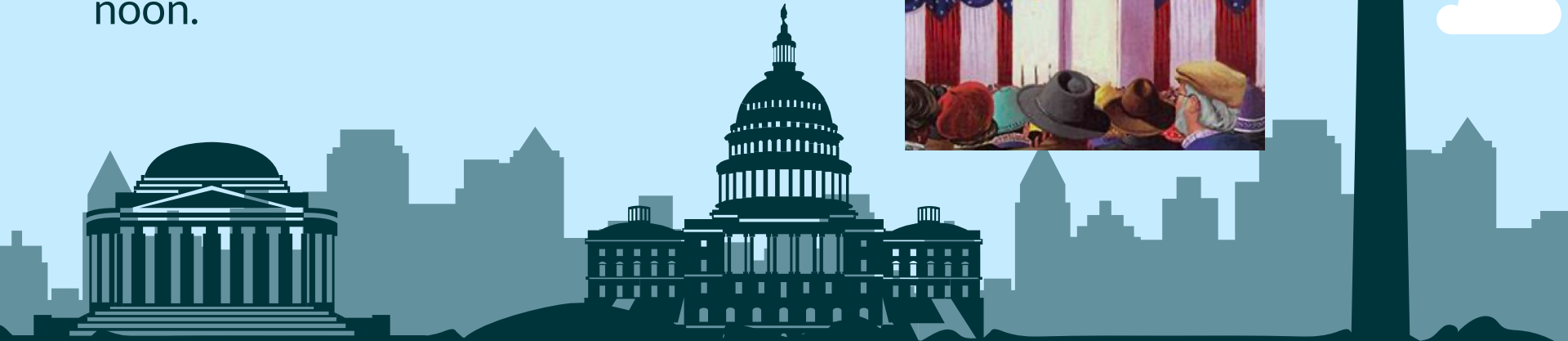
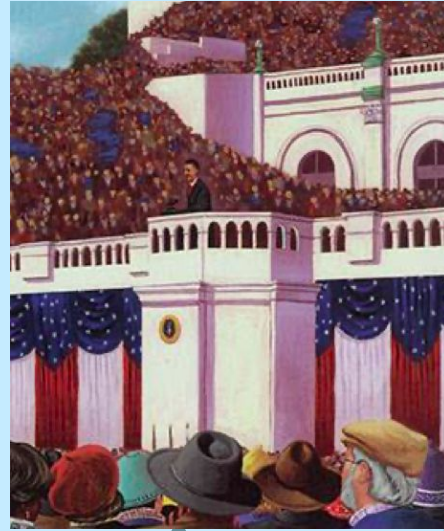

It can never be permanently defeated.

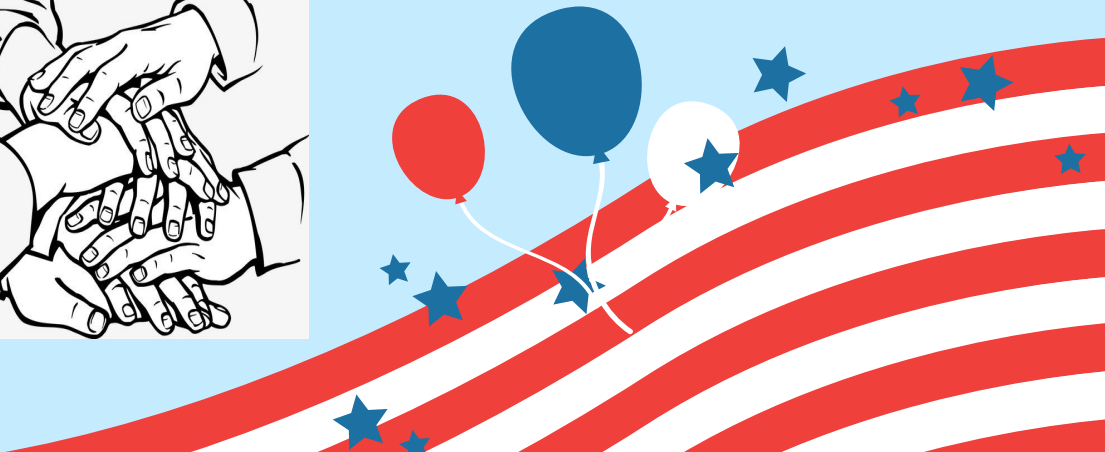
In this truth, in this faith we trust.

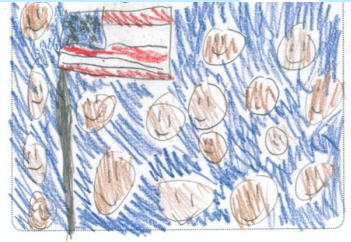
My hope for the U.S.
